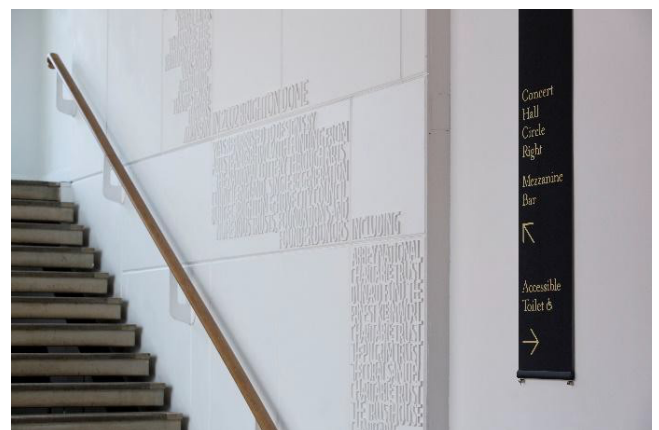
If you need to collect tickets, you will have to go to our ticket office

## Introduction from hosts

At the start of the show, your hosts Emily and Luka will greet the audience. They will introduce each act throughout the show



## First act - Delilah

Delilah is a poet. She will read some of her poetry aloud for about 10 minutes



## Second Act - Tilda

Tilda sings and plays acoustic guitar. She will sing and play 4 or 5 songs for about 15 minutes



### **Third Act – Rosalie**

Rosalie is a writer and performer. She will be performing a monologue she has written for about 15 minutes. She will also play chords on the keyboard and sing at times.



### **Fourth Act – The Hiding Place**

The Hiding Place are two female musicians, Eve and Tali. They will play acoustic guitars, one 6-string and one 12-string, and sing for about 15 minutes.



### **Fifth Act – Teleology**

Teleology are a band made up of 5 people. They will play electric guitars, drum kit, bass, keyboard and sing for about 15 minutes. **This will be a louder set.**



**INTERVAL – 25 minutes**

### **Sixth Act – Kumba**

Kumba will be singing 5 or 6 songs to a backing track she has made. She will perform for about 20 minutes.



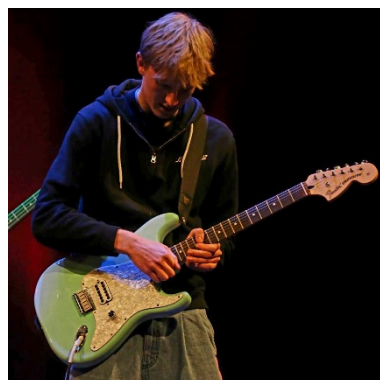
### **Seventh Act – Blue Moon**

Blue Moon are a band of 5 people who will play electric guitar, bass, drum kit, keyboard, saxophone and sing for about 20 minutes. **This will be a louder set.**



### **Eighth Act – RARE FLOWERS**

RARE FLOWERS are a band of four people who will play electric guitar, bass guitar, drum kit and sing for about 20 minutes. **This will be a louder set.**



## Closing – Hosts

Our hosts will close the night by thanking the performers and saying goodbye.
